

Inspire Scholarship Program

Since officially welcoming our first child in 2016, we envisioned the Inspire Scholarship Program as a groundtreaking intitative open to children from all communities and cultures, free from any discriminatory barriers. Designed to ensure every child can access qualify education, the program has grown tremendously. Today we are proud to report that over 560 children are enrolled in our ongoing scholarship program. Each child supported through Inspire receives unwavering assistance throughout their educational journey up to secondary school.



Special Summer School

The Special Youth Leadership Foundation successfully implemented the 2024 Special Summer School Program across eight centers in Lagos, Ogun, Ogun, Ogun, and Abuja, including Kazahchat School in Abuja, Roydek Academy in Makoko, Liberty School in Ikota, Gracehill School in Magbors, Bridge International Academy in Ojo, Eaglesville School in Ota, Golden Star Schools in Oshodi and Bridge School in Oshogot. This 3-week intensive program provided practical skill-building activities such as soap making, tailoring, coding, catering, Leadership and entrepreneurship skills for children from Primary to Secondary levels. Fully funded by the Foundation and its Partners, the program reached over 5,000 children, equipping them with lifelong skills and fostering creativity, teamwork, and confidence.

The initiative's success underscores its transformative impact, empowering children and strengthening community ties, with plans for even greater reach in the future.

Mentorship Program

Collaboration with Heritage Energy Operational Services Limited

The Mentorship Program continues to empower young talents through meaningful engagements with professionals across various fields. To celebrate International Women's Day 2024, we selected 10 female students from Lagos CHy Model College for a visit to Heritage Energy Operational Services Limited. The students participated in a thought-provising panel discussion on inspiring inclusion and enjoyed one-on-one methorship sessions with box professionals at the oranalizations at the oranalization.



Collaboration with McKinsev and Co

In collaboration with McKinsey & Company, we visited St. Francis Grammar School in Yaba as part of their annual Day of Service, impacting over 300 students. During the visit, we conducted sessions focused on building confidence, fostering self-awareness and understanding the concept of consent.

Taking a gender-specific approach, we engaged in meaningful discussions with separate gender groups, providing a safe space for students to ask gender-related questions, express themselves openly and receive tailored guidance. Additionally, books and school materials were distributed, demonstrating our commitment to equipping the next generation with the knowledge and resources they need to thrive.

Transforming Hope: A Three-Stage Renovation of Hope Primary School

The Special Foundation's School Build Program has transformed Hope Primary School in Ikoyi through a comprehensive three-phase renovation.

Phase 1: Reviving the Oasis Library

The journey began with the restoration of the long-abandoned Oasis Library, which had been rendered unusable by termite damage for over two years. Today, the vibrant library serves more than 200 students, offering a rich collection of books and fostering a love for learning.

Phase 2: Renovating Classrooms

The second phase focused on a block of four classrooms, addressing structural and functional issues. Cracked walls were repaired, damaged ceilings were fixed, and abandaned tollets were refurbished. Addition tables and chairs were provided, and the classrooms were repainted and fully equipped, creating a revettalized and conductive learning environment for the students.

Phase 3: Comprehensive Upgrades

The final phase introduced extensive improvements, including floor and roofing repairs, aesthetic enhancements, and complete electric system upgrades. A solar panel system was installed to provide sustainable energy and ensure uninterrupted learning. The installation of a new entrance signboard added to the school's identity while offering key information.

This transformative three-stage renovation has given Hope Primary School a modern, safe, and inspiring environment, benefiting both students and staffs

Roydek Academy in Makoko faced significant challenges due to its deteriorated and unconducive condition. Recognizing the urgent need for a better learning environment, we embarked on a comprehensive renovation to transform the school into a well-equipped, student-finedly facility.

The upgrades included installing new furniture, ceiling fans, and vibrant murals, along with ceiling installations, roof repairs, and new toilet facilities. These improvements have created a revitalized space that now provides over 250 students with a safe, comfortable, and engaging atmosphere for learning.

This transformation was made possible through the steadfast support of our partners, reaffirming our commitment to ensuring children have access to conducive educational spaces.
