School Build Program

Many schools lack the infrastructure needed for effective learning. Research shows that most public schools fall short of the recommended standards for safe, supportive learning environments.

Our School Build Program tackles this by constructing and renovating resilient educational facilities, helping students thrive in spaces designed for growth. Schools are selected through trusted partner referrals. So far, we've improved 14 schools, impacting over 7,500 students.

Each project is backed by an average budget of **N20,000,000 - N30,000,000** dependent on the extend of the intervention.

Special Summer School Program

Now in its 8th year, this program supports out-of-school and underprivileged children aged 8–18 with continued learning and development during the summer (July–September).

Running for 4–6 weeks, it blends academic support with practical skills like ICT, public speaking, creative arts, tailoring, catering, coding, and entrepreneurship. A baseline test at entry and exit measures each child's progress.

In 2025, **over 24,500 children** participated across **14 centers** in **9 States** across Nigeria. In 2026, we aim to expand to **20 States**.

Each center is funded with **N7,000,000**, fully covered by the Foundation and partners.

Mentorship Program

This program connects senior secondary students with professionals from diverse fields, offering real-world insights, career guidance, and life skills through classroom sessions.

In a system where practical exposure is limited, our mentorship bridges the gap, helping students understand the steps to achieve their goals and make informed career choices.

To date, **over 10,000 students** have been mentored. This year, we're targeting **5,000 more** across **6 centers**.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can sponsors meet the children they sponsor?

Yes. Physical meetings can be arranged through The Special Foundation to ensure both safety and meaningful engagement.

2. How do you select scholarship beneficiaries?

We receive nominations directly from our partner schools. They identify children most in need. We undertake a thorough screening process. Priority is always given to children from low-income households or marginalized communities, especially those at risk of dropping out.

3. Is the Inspire Scholarship for public or private school students? Why is the cost N300,000 per session?

The Inspire Scholarship supports children in carefully vetted low-to-mid-tier private schools, where consistent learning environments, smaller class sizes, and better resources are available. The N300,000 per session (N100,000 per term) covers tuition, uniforms, supplies, exam fees, mentorship, and extracurricular development, ensuring holistic support.

4. Can partners support a specific child or program?

Yes. Partners may choose to sponsor individual children, fund School Build projects, or support Mentorship initiatives. We provide tailored opportunities and regular updates to show the direct impact of your support.

5. How do you ensure transparency and accountability with donor funds?

Transparency is central to our mission. All donations are tracked and reported. Partners receive periodic financial updates, detailed impact reports, and opportunities for direct engagement, such as school visits or beneficiary updates.

6. How can corporate partners get involved beyond funding?

Corporate partners can engage through employee volunteering, skill-based mentorship, joint campaigns, and strategic collaborations that extend impact beyond financial contributions.

7. What long-term outcomes does The Special Foundation aim to achieve?

Our goal is to equip children from underserved communities with education, confidence, and leadership skills, transforming their futures and building stronger, more resilient communities by 2030.

8. What is monthly giving?
